A gender perspective means testing conventional disciplinary boundaries and developing alternative methodologies involving interactions with other categories of analysis such as race, ethnicity, class and sexuality.

Specifically, the working group aims at redefining gender analysis outside of its traditional boundaries, exploring an **alternative social economic thinking**, as well as **new** perspectives of the current economic and political predicament at both European and international level. Our work will develop around three broad areas:

- Gender and social policy;
- Gender and globalization migration, crises, finance and microfinance;
- Gender and culture representation, narrative and arts.
